

Pre-Kindergarten Curriculum

(Republic of Serbia)

Take a trip to Serbia, and learn how to dance the Kolo!

15 minutes prep, 30 minutes of class time

In this lesson, your class can be taught about Serbia and its dancing tradition. They will learn where Serbia is, and how to dance simple steps in Kolo.

Required Materials:

- 1. Photos of Serbia
- 2. Video of Serbian Kolo (about 5 mintues)
- 3. If possible, more than one adult to facilitate student participation.

Lesson Plan:

1. Begin by asking the children what country we live in, and then

help them locate that country on a map or globe. Then show them where Serbia is on a map/globe. (5 mins)

- 2. Use the powerpoint or printed images to take the children on a tour of tSerbia, emphasizing that they have a history of dancing Kolo. (5 mins)
 - a. Ask the children if they know dance moves
 - b. Show the children a YouTube video of a Serbian Kolo
- **3.** Explain craft activity to the class (5 mins):
 - a. The students will dance three moves seen in the Kolo video: walking in a circle, stomping, and kicking out in place.
