Pre-Kindergarten Curriculum

Krakow's Wawel Dragon (Poland)

10 minutes prep, 30 minutes class time

Required Materials:

- 1. Craft rolls
- 2. Colored construction paper (we used green and red)
- 3. Decorations for craft rolls (pom-poms, googly eyes)
- 4. Red, orange, and yellow tissue paper
- 5. Glue sticks for students to use

Instructor Preparation: Trim construction paper to fit rolls, cover craft rolls and glue them in place for students. Cut tissue paper into smaller strips (see photo) to resemble flames.

Lesson Plan:

- 1. Introduce students to the country of Poland through pictures.
- 2. Tell students the story of the Wawel Dragon, which led to the founding of the city of Krakow.
- 3. Explain the craft to the students. They will be creating and decorating their own dragons out of craft rolls.
- 4. Create dragons:
 - a. Using craft rolls, students will be given pom-poms and googly eyes to create their own dragon.
 - b. Once the roll is decorated, students can add orange, yellow, and red tissue paper to the inside of the roll to act as the dragon's fire.
 - c. Set aside to dry. Once they are dry, the students can take their fire-breathing dragons home!
